We believe strongly that when a student comes to camp and God begins to do a work in their lives that the best way for growth in the year to come is to go back home with an adult leader who was there and experienced the same thing with them who can encourage them in their walk with Jesus. In fact, we support that philosophy financially by paying for one adult leader per 8 students that come to camp from your church. We not only pray that students' lives will be changed, but we pray your youth group and church will be impacted by the ministry of Never The Same Camp.

## **THEME**

### POLICY

NTS Camp is for students who will be going into 6th grade in the fall through completion of 12th grade.

Students must come with an adult leader(s) as a part of a youth group. Adult Leaders must be at least 18 years old, and 1 year removed from high school.

## REGISTRATION

The registration process is simple and easy for parents and churches to navigate. All registration is done online to save you the hassle of collecting forms and money.

After you register your church at <a href="ntscamp.com">ntscamp.com</a>, online registration will be ready for your parents. They simply go to <a href="ntscamp.com">ntscamp.com</a>, clicks on register, find your camp and then your church and register their child(ren).

Once they have registered and paid either the deposit or paid in full, they will be sent a confirmation email which will include a packing list and possibly a college waiver if required by the college your camp is located at. You will receive a copy of this confirmation email for your records. You will also receive a weekly report of the students who have registered with your church and what they owe. You will have constant access to your church registrations on your NTS Camp admin dashboard.

Adult leaders who will be going to camp with your group will also need to register online, but they will not be asked to pay online. NTS Camp pays for 1 adult leader per 8 students that you bring to camp. This means if 15 students come to camp, we pay for 1 adult leaders. If 20 students come to camp, we pay for 2 adult leaders. Any adult leaders that are not covered in NTS Camp's 8:1 ratio, will be \$175 each. We will collect payment during registration check-in at camp.

You will have the opportunity to pay in full for a student by creating a full scholarship for them or you may add money to their account after they have registered if you would like to pay partially for them.

YOU WILL NEED TO COLLECT YOUR OWN TRANSPORTATION COST. It will be your responsibility to make sure that every student that you bring to camp has paid in full online and has turned in their college waiver if applicable to you.

# PRICING

Registration: Deposit or full payment by May 5: \$332

Late Registration: Deposit or full payment by 2 weeks before camp start date: \$352

Last Minute Registration: Full payment 2 weeks before camp: \$377 (full payment is the only option at this point)

\*Deposits are \$150 and are non-refundable and nontransferable

Full Payment is due 2 weeks before camp or \$20 late fee will be added

















## **DETAILED CAMP SCHEDULE**

#### DAY 1

#### 4-7pm Registration Check-In

In the last-minute details camp email, you will receive instructions where check in will be and what you need to have with you.

You will need 2 copies of your housing spreadsheet, back ground check waiver and college waiver if applicable to you.

Please bring a check, credit or debit card to camp to pay for any adult leaders that are not covered in NTS Camp's 8:1 ratio. Their cost will be \$175 each.

<u>Dinner is not provided on Day 1 so you will need to eat</u> before arriving to camp.

#### 8pm Evening Session

The Evening Session will be every night of camp. All students and adults will be led in worship and teaching from the Word. It is our desire to invite students to meet with God in ways they can relate to.

#### 10pm Opening Ceremonies

The whole camp will walk to our opening ceremonies arena and participate in the first competition of the week. Team Comps are a fun part of camp and will be explained later in this schedule.

#### 11pm Small Group Time (In Dorms)

This will be the only time that small groups will meet late in dorms. We will need the adult small group leaders to go over the rules with the students, explain the NTS Academy courses and decide which ones their students will be attending.

\*Adult Leader Time

Middle School students will gather together for worship and teaching designed for them.

High School students will choose an NTS Academy (breakout session) to go to.

High School students will gather together for worship and teaching designed for them.

Middle School students will choose an NTS Academy (breakout session) to go to.

\*Adult leaders will meet for leadership training and receive important information for the day during one hour. The other hour is free for them to rest, shower, hang out, etc.

# 11am Youth Group Time /Time Alone With God

Your youth group will be given this hour to do with however you wish. We don't tell you what to do in this time but some suggestions are: bring a guitar and have your own private time of worship, take this time to pray together as a whole group, and/or let this be a time of testimonies. God does incredible things in hearts at NTS Camp and it is our desire that your youth group is strengthened during this week, so please allow the Lord to lead you during this youth group time to make it meaningful for your youth group.

At the close of your time, students will be given a 15-minute time alone with God, so they will need to have their Bible and camp booklet which has a guide for them to follow each day.

















# **DETAILED CAMP SCHEDULE (CONT.)**

12pm Lunch

#### 1pm Team Comps Prep Time

We give you this preparation time to strategize how you will compete in the day's competition. Your team may include other youth groups, so you will meet in a central place where your whole team can meet together and work together. You will also be asked to present a team "cheer" at the end of the week. These cheers are to involve your whole team and are meant to be fun and light hearted. You can emphasize your team color or the camp theme but remember the purpose is "fun."

#### 2pm Team Comps

Team Comps happen every afternoon during the week of camp. Points will be given for every competition and at the end of the week, the team with the highest points will receive a trophy to take home and display at their church for the year. Points will be displayed during the Evening Sessions. Teams go "all out" with their color. When your church is assigned their color, we ask you to let your students know so they can pack accordingly. Some students come with color wigs, capes, shirts, hats, etc. Team spirit is highly encouraged during this time, so please let this be a fun time for your group. Water bottles and closed toed shoes are required. Team colored t-shirts and more will be on sale at the NTS Camp Store.

#### 3pm Open Rec

For an hour and a half, students will have the chance to hang out with their friends or meet new ones, compete in tournaments, possibly swim, and play yard games.

5pm Dinner

#### 7pm Evening Session/Small Group Time

For the rest of the week at the close of the message, you will be given small group questions and asked to meet together as a small group right away near the chapel to talk about these questions. This is a powerful time and adult leaders should be prepared for deep discussions.

#### 9pm Club NTS

Club NTS is a fun way to end the day. It is geared to promote relationship building within your group and others at camp.

#### 10pm Hang Out

Snacks will be offered for purchase at this time as students have a chance to hang out before bedtime.
